Participation requisites

- The seminar is open to Continental Judges and to **WA Youth Judges**, who comply with the requisites set in Book 1 Appendix 4. The **WA Youth Judges** will have to meet the requirements as per the new bylaw adopted in 2021.
- Participants must be able to communicate in the English language
- Participants must take the E-learning modules and pass the tests at least three months prior to the start of the seminar



Continental Judges and Youth Judges wishing to participate must apply to the World Archery Judges' Committee via Severine Deriaz by 3 February 2023. Once the applications are received, the WAJC will decide whether the applicants comply with the requisites and will announce the list of those accepted by 10 February 2023.

The accepted participants, through their National Federations, shall request the link to take the E-learning modules and pay for the access pin. They must complete the modules by 2 March 2023.

The seminar will be a combined seminar with World Archery Asia for possible accreditation as World Archery Asia Continental Judge status. Further information will be given by WAAs.

Applications for the World Archery International Judge Candidate status:

The applicants must possess the requirements listed in art. 7.1 App. 4 (Book 1 (C&R)). In particular, they must be accredited as Continental Judges and have been accredited as National Judges for at least 3 years, must have an adequate knowledge of English and must have served at least once in a World Ranking Tournament (or a major tournament sanctioned by their Continental Association) with positive evaluation of the chairperson of the judge commission.

Application must be submitted to World Archery Office according to art. 7.2 App. 4 Book 1 (C&R): the application (signed by the applicant (the judge), his/her MA and his/her CA) must indicate the personal information of the applicant (name, gender, birth date, nationality), languages spoken, when appointed NJ and CJ, experience at WRT (or equivalent) level.

The application has to be signed by your national and Continental federation for Continental Judges and your national federation for the Youth Judges otherwise you will not be able to pass the final exam in order to obtain the WA International Judge Candidate.

The participants passing the final examination will obtain the status of "World Archery International Judge Candidate".

The participants must bring with them World Archery C&R Book and World Archery Judge Guide Book – both available from the World Archery webpage www.worldarchery.org – and a magnifying glass.
