

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM FOR THE CHENGDU 2025 WORLD GAMES ARCHERY

Field archery

The Chengdu 2025 World Games will include an individual field archery competition for recurve and barebow archers.

Category	Quota places
Recurve men	12
Recurve women	12
Barebow men	12
Barebow women	12
Total	48

Quota allocation (listed in order of precedence)

- One (1) place for the host country (P.R. China).
- One (1) place for the 2024 World Archery Field Champion.
- Ten (10) places on the final ranking list at the 2024 World Archery Field Championships – Lac La Biche (CAN).

A maximum of one (1) quota place will be awarded per country per category except for the places awarded to the host country and world champion, which are exempt from the maximum quota.

For quota allocation purposes, athletes being eliminated in ¼ or 1/8 Elimination rounds will be ranked according to their qualification ranking (after all breaking ties procedures are applied).

Quota reallocation

Any places that are returned will be reallocated on the final ranking list of the 2024 World Archery Field Championships.

Target archery

The Chengdu 2025 World Games will include individual and mixed team target archery competitions for compound archers.

Quota allocation (listed in order of precedence)

- Thirteen (13) places awarded at continental qualification tournaments (limited to top eight places in the final ranking).
 - Three (3) at the European Archery Championships in 2024.
 - Three (3) at the Asian Archery Championships in 2025¹
 - Three (3) at the Pan-American Championships in Medellin in 2024.
 - Two (2) at the African Championships (place and date to be defined)
 - Two (2) at the Oceanian Championships in 2025²
- One (1) place for the host country (P.R. China).
- One (1) place for a para-athlete from the host country (P.R. China).
- One (1) place for the para-athlete that wins the individual compound open competition at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games.

A maximum of two (2) quota places will be awarded per country per category except for the para places, which are exempt from the maximum quota.

A country qualifies a mixed team when that country has qualified at least one compound man and one compound woman.

Quota reallocation

Places that cannot be allocated will be reallocated on the world ranking list as of Monday 7 April 2025 independent of continent.

If the athlete that wins the compound open competition at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games is from the P.R. China, then the place for the winner will be reallocated to the highest-ranked athlete in the Paralympics competition that is not from the P.R. China.

Any places that are returned or unable to be allocated will be reallocated on the world ranking list as of 7 April 2025.

¹ If the event is held before 30 March 2025, otherwise, another continental qualifier shall be organized either in 2024 or first quarter of 2025.

² If the event is held before 30 March 2025, otherwise, another continental qualifier shall be organized either in 2024 or first quarter of 2025.
