OBJECTIVE

Deliver on-site coverage of the World Archery Youth Championships in Winnipeg (Canada) as an intern with World Archery's international communications team. Work with the on-site coordinator in one of three key roles (photographer, journalist or social reporter) and send content to the remote staff or directly to the federation's digital platforms. All expenses and per diem paid. Open only to young people aged 18-23.

REQUIREMENTS

- Languages: English fluency and additional languages a benefit.
- Passion for archery, international sport and exploring a career in communications.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills and a positive attitude.

ROLE: PHOTOGRAPHER

- **Deliver** sports photography from the event for World Archery platforms and external media.
- **Need** own full-frame mirrorless or DSLR camera, preferably edit laptop and software.
- **Apply** with your best picture portfolio, equipment list and a motivation letter.

ROLE: JOURNALIST

- **Deliver** news and features from the field, conduct interviews for broadcast.
- **Need** own laptop to compose, edit and upload pieces, plus a voice recorder.
- **Apply** with evidence of your writing talent and a motivation letter.

ROLE: SOCIAL REPORTER

- Deliver social media coverage (stories and shorts) from the sidelines.
- Need own mobile phone to produce content and an understanding of social platforms.
- Apply with evidence of your creative content and a motivation letter.
