**All participants are required to handle their own visa applications to ensure smooth entry into South Korea for this event.**

However, if needed, a Visa Support Letter can be issued by LOC based on the complete information provided by the participants to assist with their visa application process. **Request for Visa Support Letter must be done no later than April 15, 2025.**

To request a Visa Support Letter, please follow the procedure below:

1. Prepare a passport copy and your personal information.
2. Send the passport copy and information to the LOC via email at [gyeyangopen@gmail.com](mailto:gyeyangopen@gmail.com)

Applicants are responsible for providing the necessary information, ensuring all details are accurate, and submitting them by the specified deadline.

All passport copies and personal information will be kept strictly confidential, securely stored, and not shared with third parties.

### K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization)

If you wish to enter South Korea visa-free, you can apply for K-ETA.

K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization) is an electronic travel authorization introduced by the South Korean government for short-term visitors from certain countries. It is a pre-entry permit for travelers from visa-exempt countries.

The main functions of K-ETA are:

**Visa-exempt:** Eligible travelers do not need to apply for a traditional visa to enter South Korea.

**Application Process:** Travelers must apply online via the official website before traveling to South Korea, providing personal information, travel plans, etc. After system approval, K-ETA will be granted.

**Scope:** It applies to short-term visitors planning to stay in South Korea for no more than 90 days for purposes such as tourism, business, etc.
