PRELIMINARY AND FINAL ENTRIES

All entries, accommodation bookings, transport requirements, flight arrival/departure information, and requests for visa invitation letters must be made through the World Archery Online Registration System (WAREOS): <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport>. This system manages the entire registration process for this event. No entry forms, hotel reservations, or transport forms will be accepted; all information must be entered in WAREOS.

Member Associations can log in to WAREOS at <http://extranet.worldarchery.sport> using the username and password assigned by World Archery. Once inside WAREOS, by selecting the event from the list, the Member Association can register its athletes. Select the “Entries” button to view the list of event categories. Select the category to enter the athlete’s data and the official numbers/details participating in that event. The WAREOS User Manual can be downloaded in PDF format (in English) after logging in.

For any technical issues in WAREOS, contact wareos@archery.sport. For any questions regarding event organization (transport, accommodation, meals, invoices, visas, etc.), contact the Local Organising Committee (LOC) directly.

Registration for the Grand Prix of the Americas Leg 2 can be made by Member Associations using the WAREOS System, or by club archers on Open WAREOS. Archers registered on either one of these platforms can compete in the individual event of the GPOA, but it is only archers registered on WAREOS that can take part in the team and mixed team events.

Only South American Member Associations will be able to participate in the South American Championship, in addition to the GPOA competition, with a maximum of 4 archers each category. Archers registered via Open WAREOS may not compete in the South American Championship (individual or team). There is no limit to the number of archers a country may register via Open WAREOS in each category.

A minimum of three (3) archers or teams is required for a category to be valid for medal counting.

Member Associations may use WAREOS only to make changes, modifications, or cancellations to entries, and may do so at any time within the relevant deadlines. The Organising Committee and the Member Association will automatically receive an email notification of any change made in WAREOS.

PARTICIPATION OF CLUB ARCHERS

Other athletes (who do not compete representing a country, but only at club level) may register in Open WAREOS at <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/> using their username and password if they have registered previously, or register to obtain access credentials if it is their first time. After creating the profile, follow the instructions to enter the event. If you have technical issues with WAREOS, contact World Archery (wareos@archery.sport). For any questions regarding event organisation (transport, accommodation, meals, etc.), contact the Local Organising Committee (LOC) directly.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Individual:	USD 250 per person
Team Manager:	USD 180 per person
Coach:	USD 150 per person

International License:	CHF 100 per participant per calendar year, payable to World Archery

The federation, club, or athlete concerned must bear any transfer costs and/or bank fees at the time of payment, as applicable. The LOC will inform registrants or the corresponding organisations of any outstanding balances. All other fees applicable to the event are listed in the Policies and Procedures for Athletes, Officials and Team Management.

Member Associations with outstanding fines from 2024–2025 must pay them before they can register and compete.

All entries received after the deadline will be rejected. Only substitutions will be permitted. Late entries and substitutions will be subject to the penalties stipulated in the regulations. A Member Association that has submitted final entries in WAREOS and does not participate will receive an invoice for the number of entries registered in the system, as well as for any other booking made through the platform (including, but not limited to, accommodation, transport, and any other additional service booked), unless it has informed World Archery and the Organising Committee in writing at least one week prior to the event that it is unable to attend.

Any change made after the established deadlines, or if final entries differ by more than 4 athletes from the preliminary entries, will automatically trigger the following penalties:

VENUE

The competition will be held at the National Stadium Complex in Santiago de Chile.

PENALTIES

- Entries submitted after the preliminary and/or final entry deadline: USD 50 per entry
- If final entries differ from preliminary entries by more than 4 athletes/officials: USD 150 per entry
- Failure to submit preliminary entries by the deadline, but subsequently submitting final entries: USD 150 per entry
- Not using official accommodation: USD 250 per person

ACCOMMODATION

Includes transport from and to the hotel to/from the competition venue. Those who do not book accommodation will not have access to transport to/from the competition.

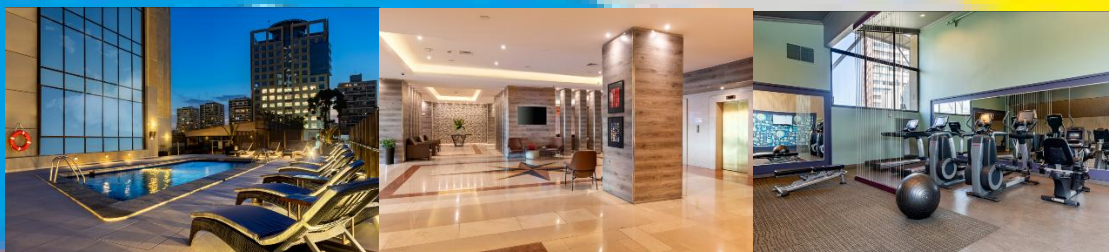

TRANSPORT

Transport will be provided for all those using official accommodation between the hotel and the competition venue, from one day prior to official practice until the official departure day. Transport schedules will be confirmed later.

Airport transfers (hotel–airport–hotel) must be booked through WAREOS under the “EXTRA” section at a cost of USD 70 per person, round trip.

VISA (OR INVITATION LETTER)

All participants who require a visa to enter Chile must complete the Visa Support section in WAREOS no later than 19 April 2026. It is the responsibility of applicants to provide the necessary information, ensuring that all details are up to date, correct, and submitted before the deadline.

All participants requiring a visa are also requested to upload a copy of their valid passport. Copies for each request can be uploaded in WAREOS. All passport copies and personal data entered or uploaded in WAREOS will be kept secure and under strict confidentiality and will not be shared with third parties.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

COMPETITION VENUES

Qualification, elimination and finals rounds will be held at Parque del Estadio Nacional.

PRE-COMPETITION TRAINING

The national archery training field will be available from Wednesday 13 to Sunday 17 May in the afternoon from 15:00 to 17:00. Use of the venue includes equipment storage, use of backstop, and two targets per person. The service will cost USD 25 per person per day, transport not included. This can be booked through WAREOS in the “EXTRA” section.

CLIMATE

In May, the average maximum temperature is 19°C and the average minimum is 5°C. Average wind speed in Santiago remains nearly constant throughout the month, ranging between 0.1 and 5.6 miles per hour. Average relative humidity is 59% and average precipitation is 2.40 mm (0.09 in) during the first ten days, with three days exceeding 1 mm. From day 11 to 20, the average is 3.30 mm (0.13 in), with five rainy days.

INTERNET

Available free of charge at the official hotel (rooms and lobby). Wi-Fi will also be available at the venue to check results; please ensure you have international roaming as a backup.

WATER

Water dispensers will be available throughout the competition venue and in the hotel lobby; each archer is responsible for their own bottle.

Terms and Conditions

Introduction

The Member Association acknowledges to have understood and accepted in their whole and without any restrictions the sale and purchase terms and conditions of this invitation package, and of the registration platform <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/wareos/>.

Consequently, the Member Association, who wishes to register to an event, and book some or all associated extras proposed by the local organizing committee, acknowledges that they are fully aware that present terms and conditions are accepted by entering information in WAREOS.

Any Member Association declares that it is entitled to enter a contractual relationship with the Local Organising Committee of the event, in accordance with these terms and conditions.

The Local Organising Committee commits itself to communicate, within reason, to its potential clients the greatest information available on the following topics:

Description of the main characteristics of the proposed products and of their use.

Pricing

Information on the methods of payment

and reimbursement conditions.

Article 1: Entirety

The platform <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/wareos/> is the propriety of, has been designed and created and is managed by World Archery Federation at Lausanne, Switzerland, and put at the disposal of the Local Organising Committee to facilitate registration to World Archery events. The present terms and conditions include any and all rights and obligations of the parties. No single, specific, or general term or condition that may appear on documentation sent, given, or handed over to a Member Association will alter, replace, or complete parts of or the entirety of these terms and conditions. World Archery reserves the right to modify at any time and without any preliminary notification of any kind these terms and conditions.

Article 2: Object

The present terms and conditions define the rights and obligations of the parties in relation to the registration made through the platform <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/wareos/> of services offered by the Local Organising Committee in the scope of the event it has been set for.

Article 3: Contractual documents

The present terms and conditions and the registration process make up the contractual documents between the parties.

Article 4: Electronic signature:

The Member Association's entering registration information is the electronic signature which is binding between the parties in the same sense as a handwritten signature would be.

Article 5: Registration Confirmation – Contract

The contract is validated as soon as the Member Association has entered its preliminary registration by entering information in WAREOS. A modification of the registration is possible until the deadline for registration set in the document. Modifications may be subject to penalty fees.

Article 6: Prices

The official prices are listed in the "Policies and Procedures Athletes, officials and team management", the invitation package prices will be based on the official price list, converted to the currency elected by the LOC for invoicing (CHF, EUR, or USD).

The official prices valid on the date that the registration confirmation is sent to the Member Association are binding between the parties.

Article 7: Payment methods

All payments shall be made by bank transfer to the organizing committee respecting the stated deadlines, with all bank charges paid by the Member Association. For any open invoices that are not settled 21 days prior to the beginning of the event, the Local Organising committee will be entitled to charge a 5% surcharge on all open amounts.

Any payments received in cash by World Archery on behalf of the organizing committee will incur a 10% additional service fee, to be paid to World Archery.

Article 8: Payment deadlines and refunds

After the final deadlines of registration mentioned in this document, Member Association will not be entitled to any refund, and all remaining unpaid amounts shall be paid to the Local Organising Committee.

Failure to do so will result in an immediate suspension of the Member Association,

who will be set as not in good standing on the day of the official practice of the event, and so until the full amount is paid to the LOC.

Article 9: Availability of services

The availability of services is guaranteed on a first-come, first-serve basis, provided that the payment of such service has been paid to the local organizing committee, partially or in full as mentioned in this document.

The local organizing committee is not required to hold services for a Member Association that has not paid in full such service.

Article 10: Force-majeure

None of the two parties will have failed in their respective contractual obligations if their execution is delayed or prevented by a case of force-majeure. Cases considered to be a force majeure are extraordinary events or circumstances beyond the control of the parties, such as a war, strike, riot, crime, or an event described by the legal term "act of God" (e.g., flooding, earthquake, volcano eruption, etc.). However, force majeure is not intended to excuse negligence or other malfeasance of a party, as where non-performance is caused by the usual and natural consequences of external forces, or where the intervening circumstances are specifically contemplated. The party experiencing a force majeure must notify in writing 24 hours after becoming aware of the occurrence. The parties will then, within seven business days, examine, unless the force majeure prevents it, if and how the contractual obligations will be met.

Article 11: Privacy statement

All information exchanged by the Parties will be treated with the utmost confidentiality
