I have been an international archer and coach, a member of the Archery Canada High Performance Committee as the Anti-doping and Education Coordinator and a member of the WA Medical and Sport Science Committee for 28 years. My professional background is a Physical Therapist and I have been involved with the Canadian Para-archery team since 2013.</p> <p>For the last 3 years I have been the liaison between the MSSC and the WA Para Committee and as such have been involved in the work to evolve this part of our sport and ensure the para athletes have the support they need from WA to compete at the highest levels. I am an International Classifier and a member of the WA Classification Committee. Our most recent and ongoing project is the rewriting of the Classifiers Handbook to ensure it is up to date with the newest IPC rules and standards and that it is a clear guide to classification criteria, processes and procedures for both classifiers and archers or coaches. We will now move on to update our current International Classifiers and put in place a program to both train new classifiers and ensure the existing team remain current and competent in their roles.</p> <p>My primary goal, if elected, is to work with the Para</p>			

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		Archery Committee members and the Classification Committee to ensure World Archery continues to support our para athletes through fair, consistent and effective classification and to maintain a clear and comprehensive set of rules and procedures that uphold the objectives of Para Olympic sport.

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

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
