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Outdoor target: the Olympic Program will be identical to that of the World Championships



Last September, in Seoul, the executive board of the International Olympic Committee accepted to add to the Olympic Games the two team trials of outdoor target, one for men and one for women.

Therefore, in 1988, two titles will be attributed both in the mens' and in the womens' divisions: the individual title and the team title.

"Ski-Arc", a new discipline

The International Union of Modern Pentathlon and Biathlon (UIPMB) and the "Fédération Internationale de Tir à l'arc" (FITA) have formed a mixed commission in order to study possible international rules of a new discipline which combines cross-field skiing and archery.

Robert Gallezot, executive vice-president for the biathlon, and Paul Zingerle, member of the administrative council of

the UIPMB, have been elected by the UIPMB; Nikola Skoric, vice-president, and Giuseppe Cinnirella, secretary general, have been nominated by FITA.

The first meeting of this commission took place on November 10 in Milano. The general rules of this sport were established. This document will be examined by the competent technical organisms of the two Federations. The commission will meet once more next May.

A certain number of modifications have been prepared for submission to the ratification of the FITA congress which will take place the 22 and 29 of March in Adelaide (AUS) on the occasion of the next world championships of outdoor target.

Amongst other things, it will be proposed that:

- A new class of outdoor target be instituted for those who are under 16 years of age;
- the field archery championships be modified by extending the trials over a period of three days;
- the field archery circuit be reduced to 20

or 21 targets instead of 28;

- the point system of the scores be modified in field archery;
- the use of arcs of compound bow for field archery championships will be introduced.

In order to popularize archery, certain actions in favor of the adoption of a less expensive standard bow as well as simpler technologies as far as fabrication is concerned have been prepared by the development and technical assistance committee in collaboration with the technical committee.

The council of the FITA will meet the congress on March 21, 1987 in Adelaide.

The President of FITA remains member of the GAISF council

Francesco Gnechchi-Ruscone, member of the council of the General Association of International Sport Federations since 1980, has kept his post as delegate of the Association of the Summer Olympic International Federations during the XXth Congress and general assembly of the Association in October 1986.

His being re-elected is proof to the president of FITA of the confidence which we all have in him.

The XXIst annual meeting of the GAISF will take place from the 14 to the 17 of October 1987 in Colorado Springs (USA). The theme of the congress will be "Sports and Education".

gets on the higher ground. Eventually archers were brought to a halt when it was no longer possible to see the spot, or even the out line of the target butt. A combined meeting of judges, jury and organising committee chaired by the President decided after examining all the possibilities, that the best plan would be the resume shooting on the "rest" day at the point at which each group had finished.

The completion of the round was scheduled at 8.30 a.m. but was delayed owing to snow falling steadily.

It was decided to start shooting at 11. a.m. Snow began to fall again, but shooting went ahead. On the last day of shooting the weather was much improved. The courses were exciting and spectacular and a real test of skill. However, the advent of bad weather and its consequences at the height of the upper Hunter's course, led the judges to recommend that future championships are arranged to be shot over courses which test to the full the archer's skill in shooting, without subjecting him to extreme demands on his physical endurance.

It seems very inadvisable to have the courses at any great distance from each other, from the control point of view and from consideration of the need for Team officials to be of service to their archers on both courses at the same time.

1986 World Records

Three world records have been achieved since the beginning of July, all of them in Asia and by Asians:

— **TAKAYOSHI MATSUSHITA** (JPN) succeeded with **357 points** at **30 m** (simple FITA round) on **July 2nd** at the international tournament in Tianjin (CHN).

— **KIM MI-JA** (KOR) with the same distance improved on the women's record bringing it up to **354 points**; she also improved on the women's FITA team record totalling **3935 points** with her compatriots **KIM JIN-HO** and **PARK JUNG-AH**.

These two records took place on **September 28th** at the XIth Asian Games in Seoul.
