The XXXVIIth Congress of FITA will open in Adelaide at the end of March.


Although hardly more than a year and a half has gone by since our last Congress, several items on the Agenda will be very important for our future.

In the first place I want to emphasize an issue that will greatly affect our possibility of development and expansion not only in those countries where Archery is not yet established but also among larger groups where FITA's Member Associations are already active; by this I mean the motions concerning the Standard Bow and the Standard Round.

Our shooting equipment and our Competition Rules have reached a level of excellence and refinement that is certainly suited to the top events of our National and International Calendars. This very situation, however, generates negative consequences in many of our Member Associations and represents an obstacle for the acquisition of new ones.

In order to overcome this, there are on the Agenda a number of motions for the recognition of a Standard Bow division with its own type of equipment and its own Competition Rules.

Now already many Member Associations deal with the situation by organizing tournaments with simpler and shorter rounds. This leads to many different competition formats making organization and participation difficult. The reduced scale, neighbouring country, club level international activity should be the breeding ground and the preliminary test for the development of National Teams. The new Standard Round wants to offer the possibility of shooting in a simpler, cheaper, promotional FITA recognized event, requiring no nights away and less expensive field equipment.

To the Standard Round corresponds the concept of a Standard Bow. We know that the market already offers a good selection of inexpensive items but we also know that the participation in a Tournament by one Archer with a top class more sophisticated and expensive bow is sufficient to make it an unequal, unfair contest and therefore to discourage and eventually deter from competing all those who cannot afford the same level of equipment. This is true both in an individual and in an international situation.

It is not FITA's intention to modify the rules we have now concerning equipment; we want rather to offer an alternative possibility accessible to many more. It will be up to each Member Association, to each club to choose when to organize a Tournament with the FITA Round or with the Standard Round.

For this reason as well as to underline the experimental character of the Standard Bow Rules and in order to give Congress an easier overall reading of the whole matter, the motions concerning it are presented to establish a new appendix to the existing rules.

It would seem logical in any case to associate the Standard Bow with the proposed new Class of the Under 16 Archers and possibly with the new discipline we are planning together with the UIPMB ("Union Internationale de Pentathlon Moderne et de Biathlon") of Ski-Arc.

If the experiment is successful in the initial period we may take a further step and go for a FITA designed, FITA patented Standard Bow that we shall then make accessible to all Member Associations, thus overcoming not only the problem of cost, but also that of the necessity of foreign currency for purchase abroad.





Brief impressions

In the prestigious Palais Omnisports in Paris-Bercy, more than 6,000 enthusiasts, without doubt the largest crowd ever gathered for an indoor archery competition, attended the last day of the IIIrd European Championship. Athletes and officials coming from all the French clubs made a point of participating in this meeting. Therefore a success in terms of popularity, but also a technical one. A giant 54 m² video screen and several cameras allowed the spectators, with the aid of close ups and slow motion shots, to follow a thousand details of the competition in an unexpected and captivating manner. Certain innovations in the use of electronics for the tabulation of the results were also appreciated by the audience. Together with my friends and all the volunteers from the French Archery Federation, I wanted to prove that this kind of archery event constituted a magnificent spectacle. We tried and succeeded in convincing the media to help us. Thus, for the first time ever a French television channel transmitted, live, one hour of our events. Our bet seems to have paid off.

Seoul 1988

Qualifying standards for admission to the Olympic Tournament of the XXIVth Olympiad,

In order to be admitted to the Archery Tournament of the XXIVth Olympiad in Seoul 1988 the following scores will have to be attained by individual Archers at least four times between February 1st, 1987 and the closing date for individual entries in the Games of the XXIVth Olympiad as established by the Seoul Olympic Organizing Committee, i.e. September 2nd, 1988.

**Women
1050 points**

**Men
1100 points**

Such scores must have been attained at tournaments as specified in Article 309.

Remember however that each National Olympic Committee is entitled to enter one woman and one man competitor regardless of the above qualification standards.

Remember also that in variance to the practice of FITA Championships only up to three Women and three Men can be entered for the Olympic Tournament.

No separate entries are required for the Teams' Events.

Each NOC entering three women and/or three men into the individual event automatically enter them for their respective Team Event, subject to their qualification for the Teams' Semifinals according to FITA Rules.

The FITA Executive Committee has homologated the *1331 points* scored by *Ludmila Arzhannikova* (URS) in the *simple FITA round* (144 arrows in 4 events: 30 m, 50 m, 60 m and 70 m). This performance took place the 27th November 1986 during the USSR Cup.

In the *indoor* category, the ten-year-old *18 m* record belonging to veteran Giancarlo Ferrari was broken, on 18th January 1987. *Thierry Venant* (FRA), by scoring *590 points*, improved it by 2 points, in Champagnole (FRA). The ex-record holder did not renounce his efforts to recuperate it, as he has still placed himself 4th during this recent European Championship in Paris.
