

## World Archery membership fee

The system to calculate membership fees has remained unchanged since 2007. In 2023 Congress, the members voted to keep the same system, but to lift the basic unit for calculations. The below is approved by Congress on 27-28 July 2023 and takes effect in 2024 and onwards.

### Calculation system

World Archery uses two factors to calculate the fee:

- The latest list of countries by gross national income per capita at nominal values, according to the Atlas method, an indicator of income developed by the World Bank.
- Number of members, based on the highest number reported in previous calendar year before 1 December. The member associations are expected to update the number of members in Extranet regularly. They are requested to provide a document verified by either the National Olympic Committee or the National Sport Governing Body every time the membership fee group changes or upon request of World Archery.
