Lausanne classification hub 2021

The purpose of an extra classification hub is to provide the classification opportunity to already qualified and potentially qualifying Tokyo Paralympic athletes who need classification and are not sure they can rely only on the Nove Mesto classification option due to various reasons.

30 May 2021	Hyundai Outdoor Challenge, 72 arrow round (mandatory for classified athletes)
31 May 2021	suggested departure

The registration to 30 May competition will be automatic to all classified athletes, but 30 CHF entry fee will apply. It is a [World Archery calendar](#) recognised event with a single 72 arrow round.

Travelling to Switzerland

According to the rules place on 27 April 2021, all passengers entering Switzerland by plane are requested to present negative [PCR test results from past 72 hours](#) and [fill in online form](#) before the departure. However, if travelling for urgent professional or medical reason, the requirement for mandatory quarantine when coming from high risk countries, will be not applied. [Read more](#).
